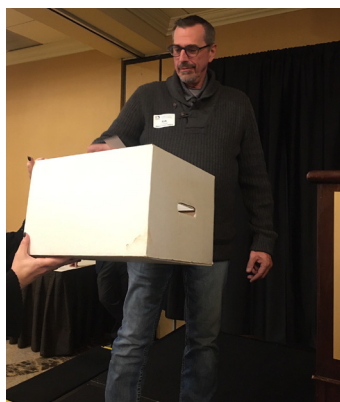


Business and Fun Mix Well at the Annual Holiday Luncheon
