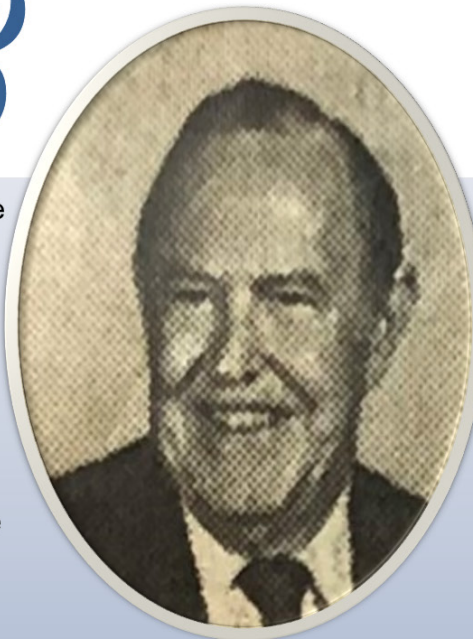


## SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY 2023
